

Company registration

Sole Proprietorship / VOF (Vennootschap Onder Firma / Partnership)

ANY OUTSTANDING AMOUNTS SHOULD BE PAID BEFORE REGISTRATION CAN BE PROCESSED

- **1.** An active, correct and accessible email address
- 2. A digital account to be created through: https://login.arubachamber.com/ → My Chamber
- **3.** Digital copy of valid passport or ID card *(for a VOF: ID of all partners)
- **4.** Extract of the Civil Registry (Censo Alf. 5, not older than 3 months) *(of all VOF partners)
- **5.** Address

Commercial Property: Rental agreement or lease agreement Residential/Property of someone else:

- Digital copy of the passport or ID card of landlord/property owner
- Approval letter from landlord/property owner
- Extract of the Civil Registry (Censo Alf. 5, not older than 3 months) or copy utilities bill (Web/Elmar/Setar)

Own property: Kadaster (Land Registry) / copy of the mortgage deed / Notary deed / stating the address

*A person not born in Aruba and who does not have a Dutch passport also needs a copy of the petition of the business establishment permit, applied for at the department of Economic Affairs (DEACI) or the granted permit.

A person of Category A: a natural person with (long-standing) ties to Aruba but is required to retain a business license, as well as a legal person in possession of the required license pursuant to the "Vestigingsverordening Bedrijven" (Business Licensing Ordinance).

Becoming a Dutch national through naturalization in Aruba

- *A person who has acquired the Dutch citizenship in Aruba and who is 18 years or older will need to provide:
- an extract of Dutch citizenship of the Civil Registry (Censo extract AWG 15: 'Bewijs van Nederlanderschap') stating the KB number and date
- the Royal Decree (Koninklijk besluit) obtained at the Cabinet of Aruba.
